WVMS Parent Involvement Policy

- 1. Parents need to be involved in creating a policy that establishes expectations for parental involvement and describes the means for carrying out the requirements. To this end, Fowler School District provides the following.
 - The Annual Title I meetings held in August
 - Site-based Committee which meets quarterly and includes parental involvement
 - Parent Teacher Organizational Meetings which take place a minimum of once per quarter
 - Various Parental education opportunities depending on need and interest
 - Our parents fill out the Student-Parent-Teacher Compact as part of the fall enrollment packet or during the fall Curriculum Night.
- 2. WVMS Parents are expected to participate in the following manner:

Each parent is required to attend the fall and spring parent-teacher conference. In the fall parents are encouraged to attend the Meet the Teacher Night Event and the Curriculum Night event.

Parents of sixth through eighth grade students are expected to attend the annual grade level event night.

Parents have the option to attend one of our quarterly Coffee with the Principal morning meetings.

3. PARENTAL COMMUNICATION:

- PTO Meetings typically take the form of Parent Education Seminars.
 Topics range from literacy, assisting students with homework, fire safety and health topics.
- A newsletter is sent out a minimum of once per quarter.
- All Grade levels provide the opportunity for parent involvement through volunteerism
- All grade levels provide for parent involvement in the child's learning at least once per quarter. The times for the opportunities are varied, at times the events occur in the day and at times it is in the evening.
- 4. Parents are kept informed of school events through newsletters, the school marquise, the phone auto dialer system, which calls parents with prerecorded messages, grade level newsletters and frequently scheduled school events.
