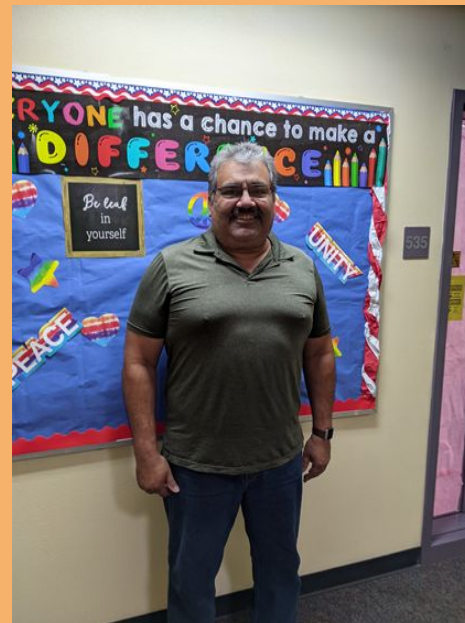
- I am originally from Detroit, MI

WVE & WVM Safety Plan

- **Security**- gates locked after student arrival; staff wear ID badges; all visitors must sign in through office; volunteers will be trained and accounted for
- Staff participate in yearly training for emergency situations, feedback provided by our Community Action Officer; District Committee on Safety
- **Fire Drills**
 - Practiced monthly, feedback given to staff
- **Lockdown Drills**
 - Practiced several times a year, with feedback given to staff after each
 - Parents notified of drills
- **Bus Evacuation Drills**
 - Practiced twice throughout the year for all students

Plan de seguridad para WVE & WVM

- **SEGURIDAD-** Puertas cerradas con llave después de la llegada del estudiantes; empleados usan tarjetas de identificación; todos los visitantes deben registrarse en la oficina; los voluntarios serán capacitados y contabilizados
- Empleados participan en capacitación anual para situaciones de emergencia, comentarios proporcionados por nuestros Oficial de Acción Comunitaria; Comité Distrital de Seguridad
- **Simulacros de incendio**
 - Practicado mensualmente, retroalimentación dada al personal
- **Simulacros de encierro**
 - Practicado varias veces al año, con retroalimentación dada al personal después de cada
 - Padres notificados de simulacros
- **Simulacros de evacuación de autobuses**
 - Practicado dos veces durante el año para todos los estudiantes.
